Linworth Children's Center Financial Assistance Program

The purpose of Linworth Children Center's (LCC) Financial Assistance Program is to aid parents/guardians of LCC children with a part of the school tuition for their child. This program will allow students whose families may not be able to afford full tuition an opportunity to be a part of the programs at LCC. Financial assistance is approved for a set period of time and must be requested again at the end of the time frame if assistance is still needed.

Financial assistance will be granted to selected students based on the financial needs of the family, the availability of funds and a space in the appropriate class.

No student will be disqualified from receiving financial assistance because of race, sex, religion, color or national or ethnic origin. All applications will be considered and the final decision for financial assistance will rest with the LCC Scholarship Committee. This committee will communicate their decisions to applicants in a timely manner.

To apply for financial assistance, parents/guardians must complete a financial assistance application and turn it in to the LCC Office. Current students in the full day, part day and Kindergarten classes must have their applications turned in by February 1st for the following school year. Decisions for current students for the following year will be made by March 1st. Current families seeking assistance with summer camp must apply for financial assistance prior to March 28th. Decisions on financial aid for current families for summer camp will be made by April 11th.

Families that are new to the program or current families that have a change in their financial status may apply for financial assistance outside of these dates. Decisions on these students will be made based on financial assistance dollars still available and in a timely manner.

Any family that no longer needs financial assistance may withdraw from the Financial Assistance Program at any time by notifying the LCC Office.

Families who qualify for financial assistance, then have a change in family income during the school year, must notify the LCC Office and be reevaluated for the Financial Assistance Program.

Families who receive financial assistance from Linworth Children's Center are required to volunteer at a minimum of one LCC event during the school year or summer.

Families who do not receive financial assistance may work with the LCC Business Manager to set up a payment plan for paying tuition.
